Parent Teacher Interviews

Parents MUST sign up using **this form** which can be found on our **school website.** The form will ask you for personal information including the contact phone number followed by selecting the time for your interview. Each phone call is scheduled for 10 minutes and we have built in some breaks to accommodate those calls that are a bit over time. Please be flexible and understanding if your teacher calls 5-10 minutes before or after the scheduled time. We will try our best to be on schedule but sometimes conversations end a bit early or late. Report Cards

New COVID Guidelines

Alberta Health Services has change the <u>Daily Health Checklist</u> for children under 18. I have attached the update flow chart to help guide your decision about keeping students home from school due to illness. The guidelines allow students with ONE secondary symptom to return to school after 24 hours IF the symptom does not worsen. RESPONDING TO ILLNESS FLOWCHART STUDENT HEALTH CHECKLIST

CORE SYMPTOMS

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Loss of sense of smell or taste

OTHER SYMPTOMS

- Chills
- Sore throat/ painful swallowing
- Runny nose/ congestion
- Feeling unwell/fatigued
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- Unexplained loss of appetite
- Muscle/joint aches
- Headache
 - Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

Legally required to isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms.

Call 811 to arrange for testing and receive additional information.

10 DAYS

1 SYMPTOM

Stay home and monitor. If improving after 24 hours, student may return to school. If not improving call 811.

24 HOURS

2+ SYMPTOMS

Stay home. Testing is recommended.
Student may return to school when feeling feeling well or a COVID-19 test is negative.

811

TRAVEL/EXPOSURE

- Traveled outside Canada in the last 14 days
- Had close contact with a case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days

Legally required to quarantine for 14 days from the date of return and/or the date of last exposure. If symptoms develop, call 811 to arrange for testing & get additional information.
