School is hoping to get the rest of the library furniture re-finished, another GAGA Ball set, a football goal post (student request), put whiteboard tables in breakout room. • The rest goes to the Cardston Active Family Foundation, which has more restrictions on how it can be used. Their next meeting is in June.
School Budget	<p>The total budget has been steadily declining because the student enrollment has been decreasing over the years. This is also impacted by inflation.</p> <p>Options to cover this discrepancy include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increasing school fees (+\$10 per student) • Extra fundraising • Volunteer bus drivers
